

ArtStart Internship Criteria-Summer 2024

Welcome to ArtStart's Internship Program for Teens! Now in its 17th year, the Internship program provides youth with real-world experience working side-by-side with teaching artists and young children ages 4 years to 12 years. Teens earn a stipend assisting staff and artists.

Note To Past Interns: If you have been an intern previously, you still must apply. Make sure to update your experience and achievements in the arts since your last application. Evaluation of your prior performance as an intern will be part of the selection criteria.

There are 16 internship positions available summer 2024. Please read the eligibility requirements carefully before applying to be an intern:

- You need to be 13 years of age at the time of applying.
- You should have some kind of experience working with young children.
- You need to attend **Camp Create for full days – June 25-28, 2024**, especially if you have never attended an ArtStart summer arts camp for youth ages 4-12 years. Camp Create is designed to give interns background in artistic skills and cultural understanding that is useful in working with artists and children.
- If new to ArtStart or the internship program, we would like to set up an interview with you to make sure the program is a good fit for you.
- You must attend the all-day **Internship Training day on Tuesday, July 2, 2023 from 9:00-3:00 p.m. at Mount Zion, 1300 Summit Avenue, St. Paul.**
- Note: **The deadline to apply is April 30, 2024.**
